

For the third year in a row, THRIVE! funded the Build-a-Garden program to help local residents grow more fresh produce in their own backyards or apartment landscapes. Launched by THRIVE! Partner Oberlin Community Services (OCS) in 2017, Build-a-Garden encourages people on limited incomes to grow and consume more fresh produce. In the summer of 2020, 43 participants received gardening materials, plants, soil, raised garden beds and elevated beds purchased by THRIVE!. “I love having it. It's nice to get a tomato or pepper fresh every day!” said one participant.
