**ST. PATRICK'S HELPING HANDS FOOD PANTRY:** Open on Saturday, March 21, 2020, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.; tel. 440-647-4375. This month we are asking that everyone remain in their vehicles. Information will be taken outside and then food will be loaded into your vehicle. No personal shopping this month. Hopefully, we will be open on Tuesday, March 24, from 6 to 8 p.m. Second Harvest has provided new bags and volunteers will wear gloves and wash hands frequently.
