

**MOBILE FOOD PANTRY, AUGUST 12**

THRIVE! Facilitator Carol Burke and member Dave Lengyel underwent Food Pantry Tracking training and organized volunteers for the Second Harvest Mobile Food Pantry at Wellington High School on August 12.

Ohio National Guardsmen and women and committed volunteers from THRIVE!, Kiwanis Club, Wellington schools and the community lifted and loaded heavy boxes of food into people's cars at the open-air pantry. All in all, 349 families were served for a total of 1,025 individuals. There were more than 289 new sign-ups for this food pantry, reflecting the growing need for food among area residents. The total amount of food distributed during the event was 32,737 lbs.
